Bright House Networks Additional Outlet Guidelines

First Floor Guidelines

- Outlet must have reasonable access to an active source
- Cannot run along or around the building if it exceeds 100 feet
- Cannot go under anything wider than a standard 3 ft wide walkway
- Any cable running on the horizontal must be placed in the ground and buried
- Drilling of holes for cable to enter building must be as low as possible and must be sealed
- Cable must be properly attached to building using cable clips

Second Floor and above Guidelines.

- Additional outlet will not be installed if attic access is not available

Inside Wall Guidelines.

- If attic access is not available only back to back outlets are permitted or DC coupler installed at outlet location only .
- Cable cannot be routed around doorways or under carpet or down hallways.
